

SMALLMOUTH BASS EQUIPMENT RECOMMENDATIONS

SMALLMOUTH TRIPS

I fish trout rods for smallmouth bass on the JDR. We are casting from a boat 90% of the time so rod length isn't that important. What is important is a rod you can comfortably cast all day long.

WHAT I BRING:

RODS:

- \Box 9' 5 weight fly rods with 1.5 bump lines on them.
- \Box 9' 6 weight fly rods for larger flies or fishing subsurface.

*NOTE: You will not need waders but some good river shoes are advised.

WHAT YOU SHOULD BRING:

- Fly rod/reel of your choice, 5 or 6 wt.
- \Box Tippet 0,1 or 2x.
- \Box Leader, short and stout.
- □ Nippers.
- □ Poppers/Surface flies.
- Subsurface flies, I like the Gamechangers in a color that is easily visible.
- □ Good Hoodie/Sun Shirt.

- □ Windbreaker Jacket.
- □ Sun Gloves.
- \Box A hat for sun protection.
- □ Polarized sunglasses.
- □ Sunscreen/Chapstick.
- \Box A dry/day bag for storage.
- Pants or shorts for warm sunny conditions.
- □ A reusable water bottle.
