### TROUT TRIPS

I like dedicated dry fly rods 8.5' to 9' max. Dry dropper rods can be up to 10'. I like 4 and five weight rods for trout. Trout Spey rods, 4 weight and under.

- Dry Fly Rod - GLoomis NRX+ 590.
- Dry Dropper Rod - GLoomis NRX+ 4100.
- Strike Indicator Rod - GLoomis IMX Pro 5100.
- Trout Spey Rod, Skagit Light Integrated Heads from Scientific Anglers.
